- 1. FRANCIS J DIXON TUITION ASSISTANCE GRANT:** This grant is open to any 2012 graduate of Lebanon County's High Schools, enroll full time at the Lebanon Campus HACC 12 or more credit hours, and family incomes not exceeding 90,000 per year. Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline for applications to be submitted is Friday, June 8, 2012.
- 2. DUTCH CRAFTERS AMISH FURNITURE HERITAGE SCHOLARSHIP:** This scholarship is open to any high school senior who has a GPA of 3.0 or higher and shows academic achievement and financial need. Applications are available in the guidance office. Deadline to apply is July 31, 2012.
