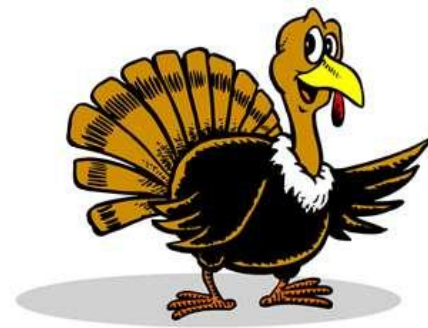

Breakfast exceeded expectations by 39 additional meals per day and lunch exceeded expectations by 57 additional meals per day. Ala Carte sales continue to be up by \$110 per serving day. USDA usage year-to-date through November was .14¢ per meal, or budget is .195¢ per meal.
