118.1 CAPITAL AREA SCHOOL FOR THE ARTS/DUAL ENROLLMENT

1. Purpose.

Upon request of a properly qualified student and his/her parents or guardians, the Palmyra Area School District will consider approval of a course of study which includes, as a component, a course at a college, community college, or university or at the Capital Area School for the Arts. The District shall consider such requests only if the request has been recommended by the Palmyra Area High School Principal and approved by the Superintendent and if the student submitting the request has demonstrated sufficient achievement in course work prior to the request.

A. The District's approval of a request shall be subject to the following limitations and/or conditions:

1. With respect to the Capital Area School for the Arts, a student whose request is approved by the District pursuant to this Policy shall be permitted to attend the Capital Area School for the Arts for no more than two credits per year for a maximum of three years. The maximum number of credits for any student shall be six credits. These six credits shall be part of the 9.5 elective credits required for graduation.

2. With respect to the student's request for approval of courses from a college, community college or university, a student whose request is approved by the District pursuant to this Policy shall have exhausted the Palmyra Area High School curriculum in the subject area in which they are enrolling in college.

3. No student and his/her parents or guardians seeking approval of the District under this Policy shall seek or obtain the School District's payment of any portion of the tuition, materials, books or course expenses of any kind.

4. By seeking and obtaining approval of the Palmyra Area School District for any course subject to this Policy, the student and his/her parents and guardians agree that the School District shall not be responsible for transporting the student to the Capital Area School for the Arts or to any college, community

Further, the student and his/her parents or guardians, by submitting and obtaining an approval of the District agrees that the School District shall not be responsible for any cost of such transportation.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the implementation of the course work approved by the District pursuant to this Policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. monitors the progress of each student who obtains approval of the District pursuant to this Policy; and2. insures certification of the successful completion by the student of each course of study approved by the District pursuant to this Policy.
