	202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS
1. Purpose SC 501	The Board shall operate district schools for the benefit of students residing in this district who are eligible for attendance.
2. Authority SC 1301	The Board may permit the admission of nonresident students in accordance with terms of this policy.
SC 1302	The Board shall require appropriate legal documentation showing dependency or guardianship or a sworn statement of residential support to be filed with the Board Secretary before an eligible nonresident student may be accepted as a student in the district.
3. Guidelines	<u>Nonresident Children Placed In The District</u>
SC 1305	Any child placed in the home of a district resident by a court or an agency of government shall be admitted to the schools and shall receive the same benefits and be subject to the same duties as resident children.
	<u>Inmates Of Institutions</u>
SC 1306-9	A child who is an inmate of an institution for the care or training of children located within this district is not a legal resident of the district by such placement, but s/he shall be admitted to district schools and a charge shall be made for tuition in accordance with statute.

	<u>Juveniles Incarcerated In Adult Facilities</u>
	A juvenile who is eligible for educational services and is confined to an adult local correctional institution following conviction for a criminal offense shall receive educational services from the school district in the same manner and

<p>SC 1306-2 (a) 1318</p>	<p>extent as an expelled student.</p> <p>A juvenile who is eligible for educational services and is confined to an adult local correctional institution following a charge for a criminal offense shall receive educational services from the school district in the same manner and extent as a student placed in an alternative education program for disruptive students.</p>
<p>SC 1306-2 (b) 1901</p>	<p><u>Future Residents</u></p> <p>A child otherwise eligible for attendance whose parent has executed a contract to buy, build or rent a residence in this district for occupancy during the first marking period of that school year may be enrolled:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Without payment of tuition. 2. At the beginning of the school year, provided that the anticipated date of residency is during the first marking period of the same school year.
<p>SC 1316</p>	<p>If the child does not become a resident of the district by the end of the period for which free attendance is given, tuition will be charged beginning the first day of the second marking period of the school year and until the move takes place.</p> <p>Parents of children who claim admission on the basis of future residency shall be required to demonstrate proof of the anticipated residency through a written request with documentation submitted in advance of the school year. This request and documentation should be submitted to the superintendent for his/her approval prior to the beginning of the school year.</p> <p>The Board reserves the right to verify such claims and to remove from school a nonresident student whose claim is invalid.</p> <p><u>Former Residents</u></p> <p>Regularly enrolled students whose parents have moved out of the school district may be permitted to finish the school year without payment of tuition, provided that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The parents move from the district during the 4th marking quarter immediately previous to the end of the school year, if the student is in grades K thru 11. 2. The student is in the 12th grade and has attended Palmyra High School since ninth grade and the parents move from the district during the 2nd semester immediately previous to the end of the school year. 3. A written request must be submitted to the superintendent for approval. <p><u>Other Nonresident Students</u></p>

Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>SC 1316 2561</p> <p>School Code 501, 1301, 1302, 1305, 1306-9, 1309, 1310, 1316, 1608, 1609, 2503, 2561</p>	<p>A nonresident student may be admitted to this district without payment of tuition where attendance is justified on the grounds that the student lives full-time and not just for the school year with district residents who have assumed legal guardianship of the student.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident children which admit such children only on the proper application of the parent or guardian.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall recommend to the Board for their approval the admission of qualified applicants.</p> <p>The Board shall not be responsible for the transportation to or from school of any student residing outside of school district boundaries.</p> <p>Tuition rates shall be determined in accordance with statute and will be payable in advance.</p>
