Palmyra Area School District currently operates Learning Support Programs at the Elementary, Middle School and High School levels. Both Resource rooms and Part-Time Learning Support classes are available to students who are determined eligible and in need of specially designed instruction.

IU 13

Palmyra Area School District maintains a positive collaborative relationship with Lancaster Lebanon IU 13. The district currently hosts two IU classes within our buildings. The Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate Unit 13 Early Intervention Program

The Lancaster-Lebanon Intermediate 13 provides services for children who are developmentally delayed between the ages of three and school age.

Some of the services available are classroom services, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech and Language Therapy.
