		206. ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT
1.	Purpose SC 1310	The Board directs that the assignment of students to schools within this district be consistent with proper education of students and the best use of the resources of this district.
2.	Authority	In assigning pupils to schools within this district, no distinction whatever shall be made on the basis of the student's race or color.
3.	Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent shall review existing attendance areas and recommend to the Board such changes as may be justified by:
		considerations of safe student transportation and travel;
		financial and administrative efficiency; and
		the effectiveness of the instructional program.
		The pupils of the District shall be assigned to schools in the District depending upon the various factors that affect the school enrollment.
		Elementary pupils will be assigned by the Director of Elementary Education. Every effort shall be made to assure equitable and fair treatment to each pupil. When it is necessary to transfer pupils from one elementary school to another to equalize class size, the Superintendent shall have the right and the authority to do so. When conditions are such that large numbers of pupils are transferred, the Superintendent shall present the recommendation to the Board for their acceptance or rejection
