223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Purpose

The Board regards the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents and students.

2. Authority

Use of Automobiles

Pupils, with the permission of parents, may drive automobiles to school, and students are permitted to park in the area provided on school property. However, the Palmyra Area School District is not responsible for any damages to vehicles that are driven to school.

Pupils are prohibited from driving to the Lebanon County Career and Technology Center or from riding with another pupil.

Exceptions will be made for CTC students who attend the CTC for the one period program, students in co-op programs and where student driving is needed to attend activities that pertain to a student's individual lab. Exceptions will be granted by the high school principal only after receiving parental permission. Consequences for students driving to CTC without permission:

First Offense: Parental Contact and verbal warning Second Offense: Detention

Use of Bicycles

Pupils, with the permission of parents, may ride bicycles to school provided pupils park bicycles in the designated areas.

The District is not responsible for theft or damage.
