228. STUDENT GOVERNMENT

1. Purpose

The Board acknowledges the importance of offering students the opportunity to participate in self-government within the establishment of the schools.

2. Authority

Students shall have the right to organize, conduct meetings, elect officers and representatives and petition the Board.

The Board will recognize the Student Council as the official voice of the student body.

The Student Council shall strive to develop a sense of civic responsibility and self-government, promote amicable relations between students and teachers, encourage friendly interscholastic relations, organize social activities for students, and consider suggestions for the betterment of the school system and community.

The Student Council shall operate under the supervision of the principal.

It shall be the responsibility of the Student Council to decide, by majority vote of its membership, the disposition of those unused funds left by defunct clubs and activities, or graduated classes who have not designated the use of its funds within one (1) year of graduation.
