229. STUDENT FUND RAISING

1. Purpose

The Board acknowledges that the solicitation of funds from students must be limited since compulsory attendance laws make the student a captive donor and since such solicitation may disrupt the program of the schools.

2. Definition

For purposes of this policy, "student fund raising" shall include the solicitation and collection of money by students for any purpose and shall include the collection of money in exchange for tickets, papers, advertising or any other goods or services.

3. Authority

Joint Fund Raising Project

Student activity clubs/organizations may jointly conduct major fund raising drives. Such fund raising activities may be conducted provided that:

- 1. The fund raising activity has been approved by the participating clubs/organizations.
- 2. One of the participating clubs/organizations has been designated as the sponsor and shall account for the receipt and disbursement of funds in accord with the procedures contained herein.
- 3. A method of distribution of the profits has been agreed to by the participating clubs/organizations in advance of the fund raising activity.
- 4. At the conclusion of the fund raising drive, profits shall be disbursed to the participating clubs/organizations as agreed.
- 5. The sponsor of the fund drive shall obtain the approval of the building principal for the fund raising activity.
