		905. CITIZEN ADVISORY COMMITTEES
1.	Purpose	Citizen advisory committees are sometimes useful in keeping the Board and administration informed with regard to community opinion and in representing the community in the study of specific school problems.
2.	Regulations	In creating a new advisory committee, the Board shall define the committee assignment and shall:
		appoint members who are interested and can make some special contribution to the committee's function, and who reside in the district;
		seek the widest range of community interest and backgrounds;
		approve appointments by the Superintendent of staff members and/or students to the committee;
		approve the appointment of citizens by the Superintendent; and
		appoint a chairperson.
		In charging a new advisory committee, the Board shall set a date for a preliminary and final report.
		Recommendations of all advisory committees shall not reduce the responsibility of the Board which shall be free to accept or reject the recommendations as it sees fit.
