- Day 1: Eight hours dedicated to programming.
- Day 2: Eight hours focused on machining.
- **Day 3:** Industry tours, providing competitors with insights into leading manufacturing facilities.

During the industry tours, Kevin had the opportunity to visit **Seyer Industries**, a premier aerospace company, as well as **Chelar Tool & Die** and **General Machine**. These experiences offered invaluable exposure to cutting-edge manufacturing processes and potential career pathways.
